JSL 2012 Class Member
JUNIOR Hours and Responsibilities

To be a member in Good Standing, each JSL Class of 2012 member must complete the following:

1. **Sponsor Requirement:**

_____ Your JSL sponsor (i.e. Mom, Stepmom or Grandmother) must fulfill her WSL/JSL requirements each year. (See WSL/JSL Parent – Mom’s Membership Checklist.)

2. **Service Hour Requirement:**

_____ You must accumulate a total of 40 approved hours, of which a minimum of 25 hours must be completed by the end of your Junior year.

3. **Working Concert Requirement:**

_____ You must work a minimum of two (2) concerts in their entirety during your Junior year and work a minimum of one (1) concert in its entirety during your Senior year.

4. **Attending Concert Requirements:**

_____ You must attend two (2) concerts, of which only one may be a Tyler Youth Orchestra concert, prior to the Ball presentation of your Senior year.

5. **JSL Mandatory Meeting Requirements:**

_____ You must attend 75% of the mandatory JSL meetings during both your Junior and Senior years.

6. **Dress and Behavior Requirements:**

_____ You must dress appropriately for all JSL and WSL occasions and display proper etiquette and behavior.

7. **JSL Fundraiser Requirements:**

_____ You must participate in the JSL Fundraiser both your Junior and Senior years.

In order to earn the **Windsor Distinguished Service Award**, in addition to being in good standing (completing Requirements 1-7 above), a Senior JSL member, Class of 2012, must have completed the following:

1. **Additional Service Hours:**

_____ You must accumulate an additional ten (10) volunteer service hours, none of which may be attending concert hours, prior to the WSL Ball of your Senior year.
